

Andrei Platonov


'A Russian writer trapped in Soviet space'



This new course will explore the life and work of Andrei Platonov (1899– 1951), one of the most original writers to emerge from Soviet Russia, with particular focus on the 1920s and early 1930s. Works to be discussed will include *Chevengur* (described as 'a swan song to the Soviet avantgarde that was to perish under Stalin'), *Soul*, and *The Foundation Pit*, all available in English translation.

This will be a five-week fortnightly course, starting Thursday 10 October, 10am-12pm in the Lecture Room, Lewes Town Hall.

EXISTING GROUP


